- **7.** If after a tie, the weather conditions prevent the Super Over from being successfully completed, or if the match is abandoned or a no result then the teams shall be declared as joint winners.
- **8.** The semi-finals and final will have a reserve day allocated on which an incomplete match will be continued from the scheduled day.
- **9.** To constitute a match for the semi-finals and the final, a minimum of 10 overs need to be bowled to the side batting second, which is subject to a result not being achieved earlier.
